Validity Of I-Card & Other Facilities Up To 31st March And To Be Renewed April Onwards (Every Year).

All Payments Must Be Made By Only Cash/D.D./M.O. In Favour Of National Human Rights Council of India Payable At Kolkata.

Attach Photocopy of Residential Proof and Two Photographs Duly Name On Backside.

Also Subscription Amount Deposited At United Bank of India A/C -0084050096070 at Any Branch of India.

RULES & REGULATION OF **NATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS COUNCIL OF INDIA** **(Protection of Human Rights)**

- The members and officers of National Human Rights Council India are working voluntarily and no payment is given to them.
- Any kind of misbehaviour or misconduct may cause rejection of membership of National Human Rights Council India.
- National Human Rights Council of India members will be entirely responsible for the misuse of their identity Card. The Identity Card must be submitted to the Head Office after the expiry of the validity period.
- The case of change of address, the same should be informed to the Head Office.
- In case of loss of the Identity Card the same must be informed to the Head Office in writing along with the G.D. immediately
- All NHRCI members should contact at Area Unit/Head office once in a month.
- Applicant can photocopy the application form and should take receipt from Head Office.
- Strict action will be taken against the culprit who is found taking steps against the rule and regulation of National Human Rights Council India
- If you have any doubt, question or problem please contact at National Human Rights Council India Head Office.
